In 2013, Richmond Foundation submitted a proposal for a project "Enhancing Mental Health Community Services". The proposal was successfully selected after an evaluation process by the Lifelong Learning Programme Selection/Grant Allocation Committee. The project was terminated in March 2014.

The main aim of the project is to exchange knowledge, values, skills and practices with other European organisations in the field of mental health well-being. These experiences have proved to be invaluable for the participants, units and organisation at large.
