Students being used as chess pawns - KSU

University and Junior College students were being used as chess pawns and denied their right to receive their examination results, the University Students' Council (KSU) said.

It was referring to industrial action being followed by university and Junior College lecturers in relation to their collective agreement.

In a statement this afternoon KSU said this was worrying not just for the students, but also for their families.

The situation was leading to problems in the application process for students following an Erasmus+ programme or who wanted to study abroad and it was also hindering preparation for resit examinations for those who failed, among other issues.
