

Online shopping with BOV 3D Secure service

Offered in collaboration with VISA and MasterCard, the BOV 3D Secure is a service that is available automatically and free to all BOV cardholders when shopping online. A cardholder effecting an online payment at one of the participating merchants is presented with a message from BOV, notifying them that they will be receiving a passcode on their mobile phone.

This code is entered by the cardholder at checkout point and the transaction is authenticated. This technology automatically recognises the whole spectrum of BOV VISA and MasterCard cards when presented at participating online stores.

ers," explained Ivo Camilleri, the bank's executive head, Electronic Banking Services.
